1.2 Let it be known that the spirit of the subject must possess the power to choose unmolested by force, fraud, or any form of coercion, and must be imbued with wisdom to discern the path laid before them. They shall be enlightened concerning the nature, purpose, and the burdens which may befall them as they tread upon this path.

2. On the Duty of the Initiators:

2.1 And lo, the duty to uphold the truth of consent is placed upon the shoulders of those who call forth and direct the endeavor. This sacred duty may not be cast upon another, for it is a personal and unshakable covenant.

3. On the Divine Purpose of the Undertaking:

3.1 Let it be decreed that the undertaking must bear fruit for the common weal, producing that which cannot be wrought by any other means. It must not be pursued in vain or with ill intent.

4. On the Foundation and Design:

10. On the Freedom to Withdraw:

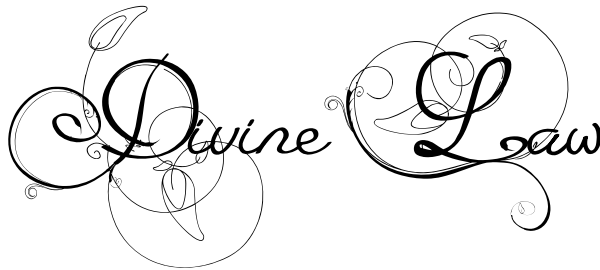
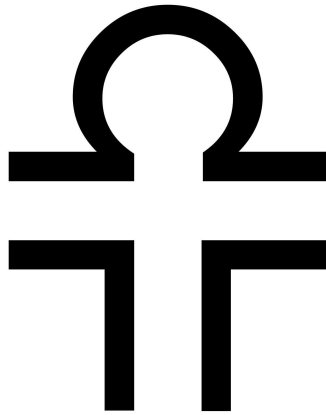
10.1 Throughout the course of the endeavor, let it be known that the subject shall be free to withdraw should they reach a state where they have not the will to continue.
